Equipment - What You'll Need

Tissue paper or Découpage Papers (you can get this from Hobbycraft/The Works/Trago Mills <u>£1.99). PVA glue and a paint brush.</u>



Step 1

Either rip or cut your paper into circles or squares about the size of a 50p coin.

TIP: The paper circles or squares don't need to be neat!



Step 2

Mix a paste of half glue and half water into a bowl. Brush the glue onto the object that you are going to Decoupage and stick on the paper. Then put a layer of the glue paste on the top of the paper as well as underneath the paper.

Once it is dry you can now display your beautiful creation on a shelf or hang the letters on your wall.
